Location

The history of Pavia is deeply connected to the history of Ticino, the river that defines life in the majority of Italian north-west. Dating back to pre-Roman times, Pavia has then become capital of Lombard kingdom, when the town shone as a multicultural center for art, science, medicine and alchemy. The University of Pavia, one of the most ancient universities in Europe, was founded in 1361, although a school of rhetoric is documented in 825 making this center perhaps the oldest proto-university of Europe. The major landmarks of Pavia, such as Saint Augustine's tomb in San Pietro in Ciel d'Oro, Basilica of San Michele Maggiore, the Old Bridge, and Visconti Castle, make the town one of the most interesting site to visit when travelling around Italy north-west. Pavia territory, marked by the hills in Oltrepo region and rice fields of Lomellina, characterizes the major gourmet choices in northern Italy by providing high quality wine variety and special expertise in risotto cooking.
